A SHORT HISTORY OF THE ROTBLATT LEAGUE

"EXPAND YOUR LEAGUE" THEY cried but the Continental League buffs refused, so the four courageous pioneers gathered in the smoke filled confines of the First Burton Lounge-highway and debated Carleton's need for a new softball league. Demand proved great and the archaic Continental League's existence was soon to be shunted aside by the vigorous new breed of the Rotblatt League. Under Messiah Eric Carlson's canny direction, our prophets, Moore, Chap, and the Berg, skillfully carved out the League's first teams from the unreal abundant yet neglected talent on campus. A fourth franchise composed of wily veterans otherwise known as Seniors was accepted on the basis of the communal use of their ID'S.

ROTLATT'S FIRST ERROR WAS MADE by Calvin Greenberg who was convinced of the strong silent even-tempered Robert Leonard's (he had not yet Goose-d) merits and thereby sacrificed his first round draft choice. Upon learning of the high honor bestowed upon him, Leonard modestly said "He made a wise choice."

THE SCORES OF THE FIRST THREE games played were 6-4, 3-1, and 6-4. Outstanding achievements in the virgin season were Body's .083 batting average, Chap's comparable fielding average, Body's .083 batting average, Art Kaemmer's 45 consecutive runless innings, Body's .083 batting average, Chip Wheaton's strikeout (He has since been farmed out to the Continental League), Body's .083 batting average, Leonard's sister's attendance record, and Body's .083 batting average.

IN ITS SECOND SEASON, THE ROTBLATT League experienced a tumultuous expansion as it added two new franchises. Commissioner Carlson, although disappointed in not getting funds from the Budget Committee for a domed stadium, did manage to talk the amiable Women's Phy Ed department into letting the Rotten Bladder boys use Pigeon Park rather than Bell Field. Eric was promptly awarded with life-time commissionership of the League.

THE PENNANT RACE PROVED the most thrilling in history as the Tunas, led by Tuna and number one draft choice Dave Jensen (who proved to be tall and cute), slipped by to a convincing one game margin. Comer's never safe Trojans led midway through the season but were convinced by their ace left handed hurler that a 6-9 record would be more satisfying — too bad about that last cancelled game boys. The Sultan's urged on by their number one spectator called Muff managed a last-ditch run to finish ahead of the Goose's XXXX. (Too bad Barbie). Some of the highlights of the season were Mort's record for flies to right, Body's home run, Ted Lutz, Body's homerun, Geyer's strikeout, Body's homerun, the optioning of Fred Hathaway to make him the only player to be traded two years in a row, and Body's homerun.
