

## CARLETON-ST. OLAF STUDENT MEAL EXCHANGE

**PURPOSE:** To promote understanding and friendship between the students of Carleton and St. Olaf through contacts made at mealtime and to provide free and convenient eating facilities for students visiting the other college.

### PROVISIONS:

1. The program is an exchange, by the students of Carleton and St. Olaf, of ~~weekday evening and Sunday noon meals.~~ *any meal.*
2. ~~Five~~ <sup>FIVE</sup> permanent meal tokens are to be distributed to each school.
3. A student <sup>within two days</sup> signs for a meal token at his food service office before he leaves to eat at the other school.
4. He surrenders the token to the cashier or head waiter at the other school.
5. The token is then available to a student at the other school to use when he eats at the first school.
6. The number of tokens a school has above five is the number of meals the other school owes it at any one time. At no time can this number exceed five.
7. No bookkeeping is involved (except that St. Olaf takes caf. no.s when the student signs for his token) because the tokens themselves serve as a record.
8. No correspondence between schools is necessary. However, a school may wish to be notified by telephone when a student is coming.
9. A school may limit the number of tokens the other school gives out for any one night if it cannot accommodate the maximum of ten people.
10. The issuance of tokens may be limited at the end of the year to achieve a balance.
11. St. Olaf students at Carleton are to observe Carleton dinner dress.
